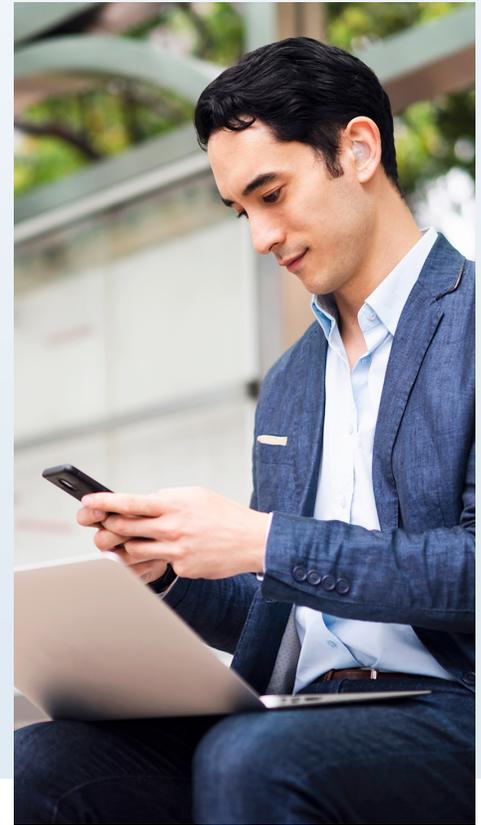




Anthology Ally Services:

- Initial discovery and analysis with campus team
- Planning workshops with key campus stakeholders
- Deployment and adoption plan creation
- Supplemental accessibility resources and materials
- Deployment support for the first three to six months of use

As a result of the **Ally Deployment and Adoption Planning (ADAP)** service, Anthology provides recommendations and action items for:

- ✓ Connecting Ally to institutional initiatives and priorities
- ✓ Creating ongoing content remediation strategies and identifying stakeholder roles and responsibilities
- ✓ Strategizing training and staff development efforts related to accessible content
- ✓ Learning how to prioritize remediation efforts
- ✓ Leveraging data from the Institutional Report to guide next steps
- ✓ Communicating to staff and leadership regarding expectations and progress
