




Instructor feedback for WYSIWYG content



How does the WYSIWYG feedback works?



Create & Edit

Start by creating course content directly in the course editor. As you type or make changes, the Ally score will be updated automatically, providing you with immediate feedback. Scores can range from Low to Perfect and a higher score means fewer accessibility issues.



Explore & Learn

You can choose to engage with the score to learn more about the accessibility issues that are present. With the feedback and guidance provided by Ally, you can better understand the issues in your course content and understand how to make it more accessible. Green is the goal!



Adjust & Improve

First determine what changes should be made. Then, you can either make quick fixes directly in the panel and preview or fix all occurrences with batch remediation. After you are done, close the Ally feedback panel and save the updated content in the WYSIWYG editor to apply your changes.
